NOTES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO STAND ENTRIES

1. The closing date for all entries will be 31st May 2022, provided all the available space has not been taken up before that date.
2. No person or vehicle will be admitted before **10.00am on Friday 8th July 2022**. If you wish to arrive prior to this date, then a charge of £10 must be paid for early check in; by arrangement only.
3. No acknowledgement will be sent to entrants unless their entry is accompanied by S.A.E.
4. Final instructions etc will be forwarded to entrants at least 10 days prior to the event.
5. Stand Holders should ensure that sufficient space is requested to accommodate all vehicles (including tow bars), campers etc., within the stand they are selling from, as entry to camp site is prohibited (see note 14).

6. **Type of Stand available:**

Class 1 – Auto jumble, **predominantly** for the sale of used or old stock vintage and classic spares and motoring paraphernalia such as, hand books, car manuals, workshop manuals, sales brochures, maintenance charts and motoring memorabilia. Sites are normally 10 metres deep and are sold with a minimum of **7 metres** frontage at a cost of £60 and thereafter in additional measurements of **1 metre** at a cost of £10/metre.

Class 2 – Antiques, bric-a-brac and other similar items at the discretion of the Organisers. Sites **10 metres** deep and are sold with a minimum of **5 metres** frontage at a cost of £75 and thereafter in additional measurements of **1 metre** at a cost of £15/metre.

Class 3 – Sales Display - for the sale and display only of cars, machinery and other motoring items at the discretion of the Organisers. All stand spaces are 10m deep with a minimum frontage of 5 metres, large stands are bookable and will be allocated on a first come first serve basis, with priority given to previous entrants. An award will be presented to the Best Trade Display Stand. Sites cost £80 for 5 metre frontage and thereafter at a cost of £15/metre.

Class 4 – Fund Raising Stands – Fund raising Organisations can at the discretion of the organisers be allocated a site **10 metres** deep and are sold with a minimum frontage of 5 metres at a cost of £70 and thereafter in additional measurements of **1 metre** at a cost of £15/metre.

Class 5 – Trade Stands - Those selling as a registered business new products or such items at the discretion of the organisers. Sites **10 metres** deep with a minimum frontage of **5 metres** at a cost of £110 and thereafter in additional measurements of **1 metre** at a cost of £25/metre.

7. Please Note - The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries which in their opinion are not in keeping with the event and further to remove traders from the Rally Field on the day of the event who have falsified the information on their entry forms and are trading out-with the scope of the class they have chosen. Stalls will be inspected to verify category of trading. It is incumbent upon applicants to ensure that the goods they are offering for sale fall within the definitions provided for each category. Where goods fall over a number of classes the applicant is asked to contact the organisers for clarification of the entry fee.
8. **ISSUE OF PASSES**
Class 1 - Frontages of 7 metre SVVC members – 3 free weekend passes; non-members 2 free weekend passes. For frontages in excess of 7 metres 1 free additional weekend pass will be issued per additional 3 metres of frontage up to a maximum of 2 free additional passes. Classes 2-5; 5 Metre frontage 2 free weekend passes. For frontages in excess of 5 metre 1 addition free weekend pass per additional 2 metre frontage up to a maximum of 2 additional free weekend passes. Passes required in excess of the free allocation can be purchased at a cost of £12 per person and should be purchases in advance with the entry form.
9. Stands will not be permitted to partake in any political campaigning. Failure to adhere to this will result in removal from the event without any refund.
10. Sub letting of sites on the day will not be permitted and failure to adhere to this will result in all parties concerned being stopped from trading and being removed
11. Trading out-with the official allocated areas will not be permitted.
12. For the purpose of allocating weekend person passes an “entrant” is deemed to be either a firm/organisation or a single named person.
13. No refunds will be given for pre paid weekend person passes.
14. Camp Site – Due to the increased number of vehicle entrants and the lack of available space it is regretted that it is not possible to allow stallholders the use of the campsite in addition to their allocated stand area. Those wishing to stay the weekend must camp within their own stand area. Please note Strathmore Estates will not permit any over night parking or camping anywhere else on the estate. This includes areas designated as bus or car parks on which parking only is allowed for the time the event is open to the public.
15. Please Note: Stall holders must have in close proximity, within their stand or support vehicle, a suitable, compliant, fire extinguisher, this will be checked by an SVVC official.
