## NOTES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CAR CLUB ENTRIES

1. The closing date for all entries will be 10th May 2026, provided all the available space has not been taken up before that date.
2. Space will be provided on a first come first served basis, with priority given to those clubs who have completed all aspects of the form. Camping forms must be completed/paid for all entrants wishing to come at the time of form submission.
3. No person or vehicle will be admitted before **10.00am on Friday 10th July 2026.**
4. No acknowledgement will be sent to entrants unless their entry is accompanied by S.A.E.
5. Final instructions etc will be forwarded to entrants at least 10 days prior to the event.
  - 5.1 All persons must display a wristband pass which must be worn for the duration of the event.
6. Entries can be accepted from car clubs at organisers discretion. Vehicles will not be eligible for judging, however an award for best car club display will be awarded.

Site fee will be £80, which will include free weekend passes for 2 adults and 2 children (under the age of 16) per vehicle This will allow up to 10 vehicles onto the allotted area. Additional vehicles will be charged at £8 per vehicle. We ask that you email for verification of a larger site being available. Any additional persons attending with clubs must purchase weekend person passes in advance with entry at a cost of £15 each.
7. Insurance Cover & movement of vehicles outwith Club Stand
  - 7.1 If erecting any structure in your display stand, you must ensure you are in possession of liability insurance to the cover of £5 million. If it is only vehicles in your display then individual vehicle insurance will suffice.
  - 7.2 It is the responsibility of all persons whether they are named entrants or not to ensure that prior to driving any vehicle anywhere in the rally area that the driver is legally covered against third party risk (Owners of the vehicles have the additional responsibility to ensure they do not "cause or permit" a contravention of this legal requirement).
  - 7.3 No person shall drive any vehicle within the rally area without being the holder of a Driving Licence covering the type of vehicle to be driven.
  - 7.4 No person shall be carried anywhere within the rally area on any vehicle which is not constructed or adapted to carry passengers. For the avoidance of doubt dual seat tractors do not constitute a passenger carrying vehicle and should be used solely by the driver.
  - 7.5 During the event no vehicle shall be driven from the vehicle compound except where its movement is co-ordinated with the Compound Marshall.
8. **Please Note - The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entries which in their opinion are not in keeping with the event and further to remove persons from the Rally Field on the day of the event who have falsified the information on their entry forms.**
9. Period Dress Parade - A special prize for the vehicle with occupants dressed in costume of the same era will be awarded. The parade will take place in the main ring on Sunday afternoon.
10. For the purpose of allocating weekend person passes an "entrant" is deemed to be either a firm/organisation or a single named person.
11. No refunds will be given for pre paid weekend person passes.
12. Camp Site – Should any person within your club require a campsite space please ensure that the camping form is completed per entrant. Camping cost of £20/weekend, with entry. This includes access to a shower block. Please note Strathmore Estates will not permit any overnight parking or camping anywhere else on the estate. This includes areas designated as bus or car parks on which parking only is allowed for the time the event is open to the public.
13. If operating a generator within campsite please be mindful of those around you and adhere to our policy of entrants only using between the hours of 9am & 11pm. An area will be set aside in the campsite for those wishing to park in a quieter area.
