# NOTES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO VEHICLE ENTRIES

1. The closing date for all entries will be 10th May 2026, provided maximum entries have not been reached and available space taken up before that date.
2. No person or vehicle will be admitted before 10 am, on Friday 10th July 2026 unless early arrival fee has been paid and arranged. Early arrival is permitted between the hours of 10am and 4pm on Thursday 9th July 2026.
3. Would all entrants please note that this is a 2-day event and that we prefer to display vehicles on both days, in fairness to paying members of the public. Due to complaints by members of the public we have had to introduce an attendance check; the appropriate box must be marked and adhered to. Forms not completed will be returned to the entrant. Checks will be completed at the event to ensure compliance. Also we would ask that vehicles in attendance be brought to the appropriate compound and not left in the campsite; vehicles should reach compound no later than 9am on days of attendance.
4. No vehicle (entrant or otherwise) will be admitted to the rally field after 10 a.m. on Sunday, 12th July 2026. This rule will be strictly adhered to and unfortunately all late arrivals regardless of reason will be asked to park in the public car park. All vehicles must be presented for judging by 9 a.m. on Sunday 12th July 2026.
5. No acknowledgement will be sent to entrants unless their entry is accompanied by S.A.E.
6. Final instructions, & vehicle number will be forwarded to entrants at least 10 days prior to the event. Passes will be distributed at appropriate reception upon arrival.
  - 6.1 All persons must display a wristband pass which must be worn for the duration of the event.
7. Priority will be given to older vehicles. Entries will be accepted from all vehicles manufactured up to and including 1985.
8. Stationary Engines  
Following the introduction of more stringent recommendations by the Health & Safety Executive the following regulations will apply to stationary engines.
  - 8.1 When in operation a Stationary Engine must be attended at all times by either the entrant or a responsible person delegated by the entrant.
  - 8.2 Although the Organising Committee will provide a double fenced compound to prevent unauthorised entry by members of the public and sufficient space within the compound to ensure that a reasonable distance is available between the engines it is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that no person can approach beyond a safe distance his / her engine whether it is operating or not from within the compound area.
  - 8.3 The only people permitted within the Stationary Engine Compound are the entrants or in the absence of any entrant one responsible person acting on his / her behalf, the Stationary Engine Judge and the officially appointed Compound Marshall or other Compound Director as required.
  - 8.4 All entries must be in possession of relevant insurance. Please provide copy upon entry.
9. Where circumstances dictate it necessary to make a vehicle substitution these may be permitted to attend but must be parked in the compound reserved for the original entry. Vehicles in this category will not be eligible for awards and you should contact the organisers as soon as possible to seek permission to change.
10. Vehicle Entry Fee – SVVC Members £6 per vehicle. Non-Members £8 per vehicle. This fee entitles entry for a family of four (consisting of 2 adults and 2 children under the age of sixteen). All other persons in the party will be charged on arrival.

11. Period Dress Parade – A special prize for the vehicle with occupants dressed in costume of the same era will be awarded. The parade will take place in the main ring on Sunday afternoon.
12. Insurance Cover & movement of vehicles outwith Compounds
  - 12.1 It is the responsibility of all persons whether they are named entrants or not to ensure that prior to driving any vehicle anywhere in the rally area that the driver is legally covered against third party risk (Owners of the vehicles have the additional responsibility to ensure they do not “cause or permit” a contravention of this legal requirement).
  - 12.2 No person shall drive any vehicle within the rally area without being the holder of a Driving Licence covering the type of vehicle to be driven.
  - 12.3 No person shall be carried anywhere within the rally area on any vehicle which is not constructed or adapted to carry passengers. For the avoidance of doubt dual seat tractors do not constitute a passenger carrying vehicle and should be used solely by the driver.
  - 12.4 During the event no vehicle shall be driven from the vehicle compound except where its movement is co-ordinated with the Compound Marshall.
13. Camping – Due to the limited size of the campsite camping, at a cost of £20, will only be provided to the Vehicle Entrants who have completed the appropriate entry form. This includes access to a shower block in the campsite. Admission to the campsite will be by the production of the special entry number, which will allow only one vehicle entry, and all persons entering the campsite must possess a person entry pass. PERSON PASSES WILL ONLY BE ISSUED AT RECEPTION ON PRESENTATION OF THE ENTERED VEHICLE. This means that booking into the campsite will be possible ONLY DURING THE TIMES RECEPTION IS OPEN. It should be further noted that Strathmore Estates will not permit any overnight parking or camping anywhere else on the Estate. This includes any areas designated as bus or car parks on which parking only is allowed between the times the event is open to the public.
14. If operating a generator within campsite please be mindful of those around you and adhere to our policy of entrants only using between the hours of 9am & 11pm. An area will be set aside in the campsite for those wishing to park in a quieter area.
15. Young Enthusiasts constitutes a young person under 16 entering an exhibit.
